ATTENTION RUTHERFORD RESIDENTS – A Special Election has been scheduled for Rutherford residents for the election of a Council person. This election has been scheduled for Tuesday, March 9, 2010 with polls opened from 6:00 am to 8:00 pm. Residents will vote at their usual polling site.

Please be aware that the deadline to register to vote for this Special Election is **Tuesday, February 16, 2010**. The Borough Clerk's office will be opened from 8:30 am to 9:00 pm on February 16th for registration.

Any resident may register to vote in the Borough Clerk's Office in Borough Hall at 176 Park Avenue during regular office hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. You may also call and request a form mailed to the home or go to website - co.bergen.nj.us/countyclerk.

All residents are reminded of the following to ensure their voting privilege: You must re-register if you have not voted in any election for 4 consecutive years, you have moved, you have changed your address.

Also, there is a deadline to request a **MAIL-IN BALLOT** by mail. Your application must be at the County Clerk's Office by **March 2nd**. **College students and residents** who are not available to vote at their polling place may complete this form, mail it to the County and receive an absentee ballot in the mail. These forms are also available at the Borough Clerk's office.

Rutherford Board of Education Election

Rutherford's Board of Education election will be held on **Tuesday, April 17, 2007. Polling places will be opened from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.** You will receive a sample ballot prior to the election and you vote at the same place as the primary and general election. All residents are urged to exercise their right to vote. Deadline to register to vote in March 27, 2007.

If you are not available to vote on this day, you may apply for an **ABSENTEE BALLOT** by mail. Your application must be at the County Clerk's Office no later than **April 10th at 4:00 P.M.** College students and residents who will be out of the area on this date should be aware of this and allow enough time to mail their application. These application forms are available to you at the Borough Clerk's Office which you may call for or pick up. If you miss the mail-in deadline, you may go directly to Hackensack up until 3:00 p.m. the Monday before the election (April 16th) and vote on an absentee ballot. Also, you may vote in person on an absentee ballot on **Saturday, April 14th from 9 am to 1 pm in Hackensack at the Bergen County Clerk's office located at One Bergen County Plaza, Room 120, Hackensack, 336-7020.**
